Unfortunately we must inform you that we are currently lacking capacities to perform the living donor transplant and cannot estimate at this time when clinical capacities would allow us to proceed with your request. Thus we feel that it would be in your best interest if we let you know in advance in order to give you the opportunity to approach another transplant center which could guarantee a timely transplant.

Living donor kidney transplantation is a very well established treatment for end stage renal failure in numerous centers around europe and as such, there are plenty of highly skilled and experienced transplant centers which can probably be of quicker help for you than we are at this moment.
